## **LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTURE DESIGN STUDIO**

### **BIOS – TECHNOLOGICAL GARDENS**

#### **OBJECTIVES**

The aim of the course is to improve students' knowledge of green areas, which are often merely conceived as street furnishings or interruptions to the urban fabric, and to enable them to consider them as true design elements, with their many unique technological opportunities. In the final workshop session, participants will work as a team to create a small garden area using the appropriate materials, as a practical opportunity of exploring a real solution to achieve different results.

#### **MAIN TOPICS**

The course looks at the city of Milan as a platform for the study of contemporary design culture, in a sector that combines a densely constructed territory with the natural (artificially natural) environment: the world of rooftop gardens.

Starting from this relationship, the course will explore technological green areas, their values, techniques and methods, by means of lectures and the development of a project.

#### **CALENDAR AND ATTENDANCE**

**5 July - 16 July, 2010**

45 hours' lessons: on Monday 5th July there will be an orientation session from 10 am to 11 am, lessons from 11 am to 1 pm, lunch break from 1 pm to 2 pm and lessons again from 2 pm to 5 pm. On the other days there will be lessons from 10 am to 1 pm and from 2 pm to 4 pm. There will be no lessons on Friday 9 July. Attendance is mandatory.

#### **CANDIDATE PROFILE**

The course is designed for students studying at faculties of Landscape Design, Interior Design, and Architecture. It comprises architectural design, site planning, environmental restoration, town or city planning, urban design, parks and the design of recreational areas.

The course is also open to second year university students with differing design backgrounds, who desire to extend their knowledge and understanding of Landscape Architecture.

Students will have to be motivated and inquisitive, with an aptitude for individual and group work.
